Chair report March 12,2021

Hi family,

NA and my service work are very important to me but I also have to work so I am requesting that any and all NA business be taken care of at it's appropriate meetings and not outside of that. No one person represents Narcotic Anonymous or this areas business. When doing this the home groups are being left out of the decision making process. Also everyone's opinion is valid it's not what you say it's how you say it, and the fact that you can remain open-minded enough to hear what other people have to say to. In doing my duty as the elected chair I will continue to try to maintain order during the area. And if you believe that I am wrong you have the right to challenge my decision but you do not have the right to act out of order and will not be allowed to disrupt the whole meeting.

It was said that I violated the By-Laws last month, by allowing GSR's to vote on this year's budget in February instead of March. In going over the By-Laws in Article XI amended 9/12/93) section 2 it states that the "officers SHALL present this budget to be amended and approved by the voting members at the RASC in March." This amendment is 27years old and no longer applies to this area. Went it was put in place we were holding our convention in February and March which played a part in our financial reasoning for this amendment. At this time we no longer hold the convention at that time. In looking back over several years of minutes there has been no consistent vote on the budgets. Another thing to remember is that just because they were voted on does not mean that they have to start using them right away.

I know that this area voted on motion 20200209-01 in March of 2020 which states that we subscribe to an online cloud service but it does not state which one. And the PR sub-committee recommends Office 365 but we don't have enough information to go by or enough to start using this system right away. We will be having an in person Area meeting on May2,2021

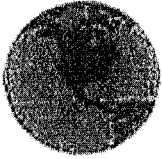
